Scoring Guide:

- For each "a" response, assign 0 points.
- For each "b" response, assign 1 point.
- For each "c" response, assign 2 points.

Interpretation:

- 0-10 points: Low risk of Developmental Language Disorder (DLD).
- 11-20 points: Moderate risk of DLD. Consider seeking further evaluation from a qualified professional.
- 21-30 points: High risk of DLD. It's advisable to seek evaluation and support from a speech-language pathologist or other specialist.

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
